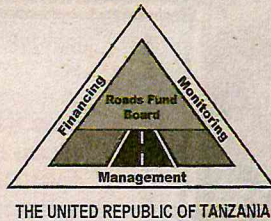

1. This invitation for expression of interest follows the General Procurement Notice (GPN) which appeared in The Guardian and Daily News dated 16th September, 2014.
 2. The Government of the United Republic of Tanzania has set aside funds for the operation of the **Roads Fund Board** during the financial year 2014-2015. It is intended that part of the proceeds of the fund will be used to cover eligible payment under the contract for the ESTABLISHMENT OF BASELINE ROADS NETWORK IDENTIFICATION AND INVENTORY DATA OF MAINLAND TANZANIA.
 3. The **Roads Fund Board** now invites eligible consultants to indicate their interest in providing the services which include:
 - Review the existing road and bridges data collection practices and guidelines
 - develop harmonised data collection principles, procedures and guidelines for this assignment and for future use
 - Collection of data for roads identification (numbering and centreline coordinates), verification of road lengths, inventory, condition and traffic data in order to have baseline data for the entire public roads network
 - Establishment of a GIS database for the public road network.
 - Supply of Laser scanner and use it for condition survey of paved roads for automatic measuring of roughness, rutting, cracks, potholes, texture etc.
- N:B** This assignment is for the entire Mainland Tanzania that has 25 administrative Regions and the implementation period is 30 months.
4. Interested firms must provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services by submitting consultant's profile, description of similar assignments, experience in similar conditions, availability of appropriate skills among staff, etc. Consultants may associate to enhance their qualifications.
 5. A consultant will be selected in accordance with the procedures set out in the Public Procurement Act No. 7 of 2011 and the Public Procurement Regulations, 2013 – Government Notice No. 446 (hereinafter called Procurement Regulations).
 6. Selection will be conducted through the "Quality and Cost based" selection procedures specified in the Public Procurement Regulations.
 7. Interested eligible consultants may obtain further information from the office of the **Secretary, Roads Fund Board Tender Board, Mawasiliano Towers, 1st Floor, Sam Nujoma Road, P.O.
